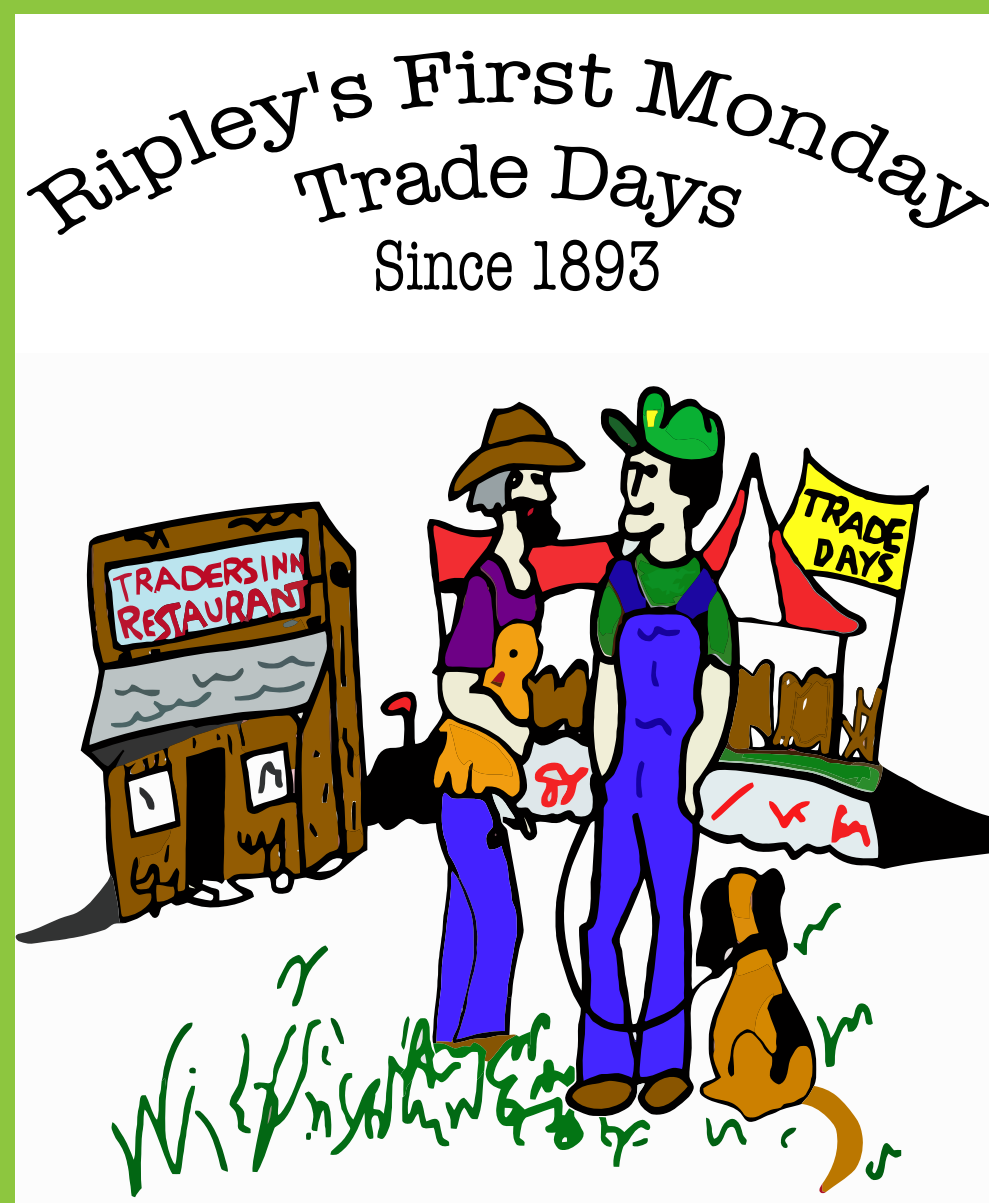

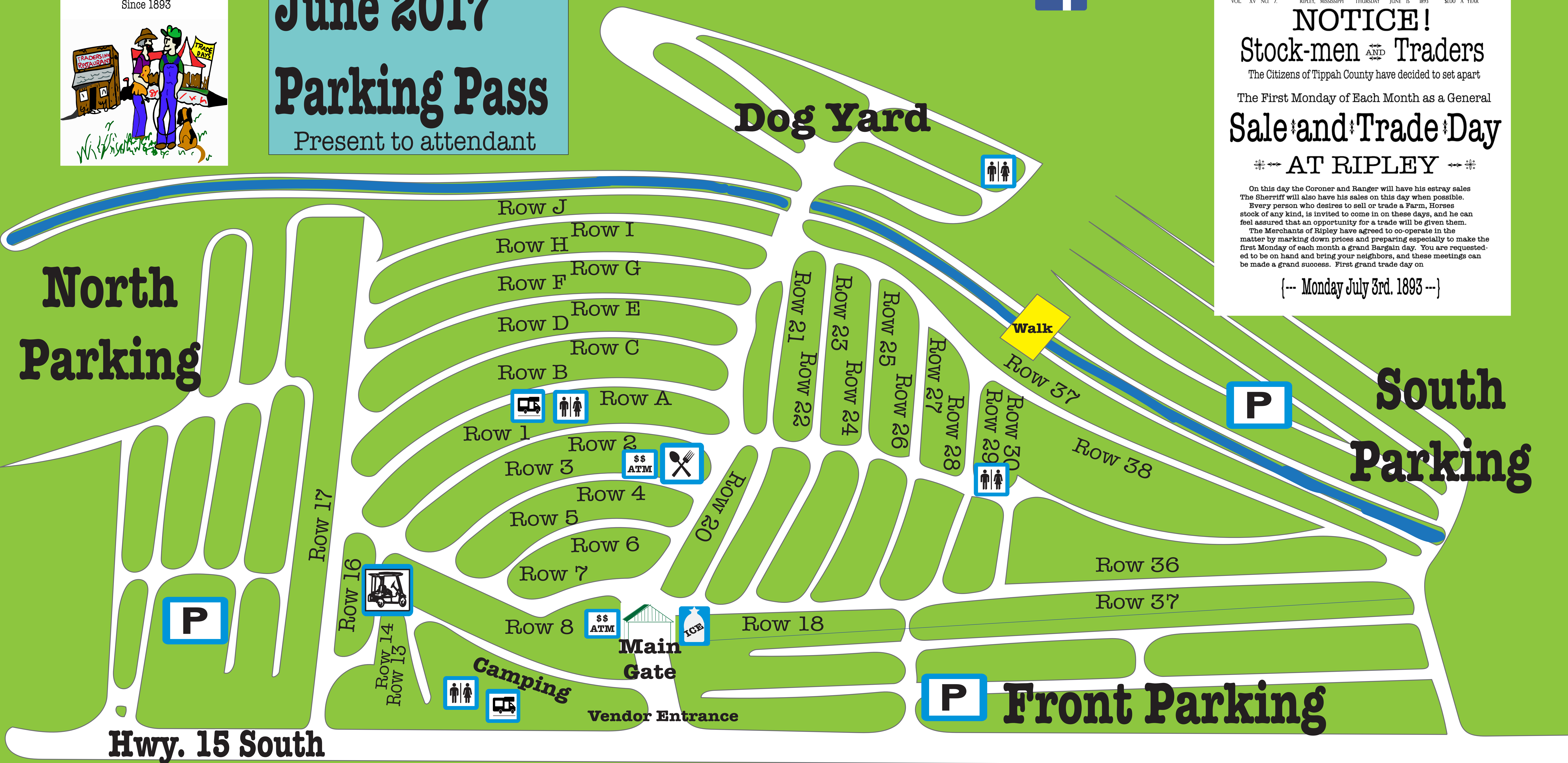

**First Monday Trade Days** is Mississippi's largest and one of the country's oldest known organized flea markets. 50 acres located on State Hwy 15 in Ripley, MS, approximately 75 miles Southeast of Memphis. Moved from the original site on the Court Square to it's present site south of the city limits. The First Monday grounds offer free admission to the public, dining facilities, electrical hookups, dump station, showers, table rental, TV cable hookups, early morning Church services. The Flea Market is proud of the assortment of delicious foods, offered by many concessions, especially the air conditioned Traders Inn Cafeteria with 150 person seating capacity. First Monday dealers display a large variety of items ranging from the unusual items, hard to find items, antiques, new, used, crafts, pets & much more.
